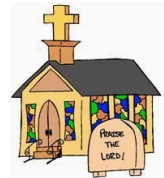

There will be no St. Rita Rosary Society meetings during the summer months. Will resume again in September

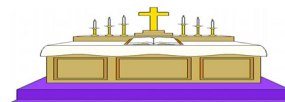
