**RECONCILIATION (Confession)**

Saturday 4:15pm—4:45pm. Any other time, call the Rectory for an appointment with one of the priests.

**BAPTISM** If you desire to have your child baptized into the Catholic Faith, please call the Rectory for an appointment. A class prior to the celebration is required. Children 7 years & older must prepare for Baptism by attending Religious Instructions.

**MATRIMONY** Couples must make arrangements at the Rectory 8 months before the Marriage. Both parties must see the priest. All couples must attend the Pre-Cana program. Log onto [www.pre-cana.org](http://www.pre-cana.org) for introductory session and dates.

**ANOINTING OF THE SICK** If there is someone sick at home, please contact one of the priests to administer the sacrament at home; Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion are also available to bring Eucharist. Urgent calls are responded to at any time.

**RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION OF ADULTS (RCIA)** Any adult (18+) who wishes to be Baptized into the Catholic Faith or who needs to complete the Sacraments of Initiation (Eucharist, Confirmation) is asked to call the Rectory for information.
