**BAPTISM** If you desire to have your child baptized

 appointment. A class prior to the celebration is required.  
 Children 7 years & older must prepare for Baptism by  
 attending Religious Instructions.

**MATRIMONY** Couples must make arrangements at  
 the Rectory 8 months before the Marriage. Both parties  
 must see the priest. All couples must attend the Pre-Cana

RCIA is also for baptized Catholics who have not received both First Holy Communion and Confirmation. The sessions meet once a week on Thursday at 7pm in the Rectory.
