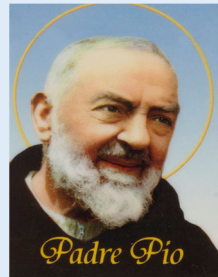


***Holy Hour***

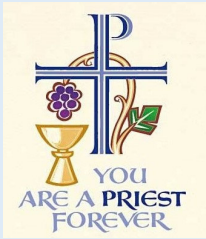

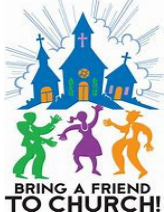

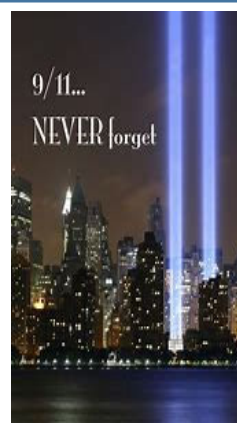
**A Prayer for Labor Day**

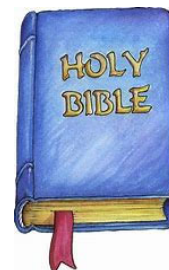

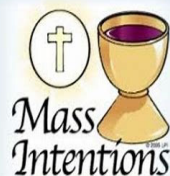
